

Getting to Boulder by Car

Driving from DIA to Boulder

WITH TOLLS (FASTEST)

1. Head west on Peña Boulevard
2. Take exit 6B toward Boulder/Ft. Collins
3. Merge onto E-470 west
4. Continue onto Northwest Parkway
5. Take the exit onto US 36 West (right)
6. Take 1st Boulder exit to Foothills Parkway
7. Head north on Foothills for about 3 miles, past Baseline, Arapahoe, & Pearl
8. Take exit after Pearl onto Valmont Road
9. Turn right (east) on Valmont for 1 mile
10. Turn left (north) onto Sterling Circle (last left before it turns right)

NO TOLLS — FROM THE EAST

1. Head west on Peña Boulevard
2. Merge onto I-70 west
3. Exit onto I-270 west
4. Follow signs to Boulder US 36 West (left)
5. Take 1st Boulder exit to Foothills Parkway
6. Head north on Foothills for about 3 miles, past Baseline, Arapahoe, & Pearl
7. Take exit after Pearl onto Valmont Road
8. Turn right (east) on Valmont for 1 mile
9. Turn left (north) onto Sterling Circle (last left before it turns right)

Driving to Boulder from other areas of Colorado

FROM THE NORTH

1. Take I-25 south
2. Take exit 240 (CO 119) east through Longmont
Or take exit 235 (CO 52) east to CO 119
3. Take CO 119 (also called Diagonal Highway) south into Boulder
4. Follow signs to CO 157 (Foothills Parkway) south
5. Turn left (east) on Valmont Road
6. Drive for 1 mile, turn left (north) onto Sterling Circle (last left before it turns right)

FROM THE SOUTH

1. I-25 north
2. Exit at US 36 west toward Boulder (left exit),
3. Drive 17 miles then take 1st Boulder exit to Foothills Parkway
4. Head north on Foothills for about 3 miles, past Baseline, Arapahoe, & Pearl
5. Take exit after Pearl onto Valmont Road
6. Turn right (east) on Valmont for 1 mile
7. Turn left (north) onto Sterling Circle (last left before it turns right)

FROM THE WEST

1. Take I-70 East, follow signs to CO 93 north to Boulder
2. CO 93 becomes Broadway in Boulder
3. Go through downtown Boulder, then take a right onto Balsam Ave.
4. Drive 3 miles, Balsam becomes Valmont Rd.
5. Turn left (north) onto Sterling Circle (last left before it turns right)
